AWARDS

Belt buckles will be awarded to overall Champion, Lewis Class 1 Champion and Runner-up, Lewis Class 2 Champion and Runner-up and Lewis Class 3 Champion and Runner-up.

Total belt buckles seven (7).

Scholarship Awards:

- Scholarships will be offered to two groups – collegiate and non-collegiate.
- Collegiate participants must present college ID or acceptance letter to be eligible for this group.
- Any youth not in college will compete in the non-collegiate group.
- Each group will be awarded \$1250, \$750, \$500 to the top three shooters in each group.

Total scholarship \$ awarded \$5000. If a winner is not in college yet, NSSA will hold funds until that individual attends college or tech school full time (min. 12 credit hours) and has a minimum GPA of 3.0. Funds will be released after first semester upon proof of these requirements.
