

# **Super Sporting**

# **ELIGIBILITY**

This is an open event of the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Junior Shoot-Out. Every person in these four categories is eligible to enter:

- Adult Participant Any person who is over the age of 18 or has completed twelfth grade who will be shooting on NSC grounds Wednesday, February 16 to Sunday, February 20, 2022.
- Collegiate Participant Any person who is a member of a recognized collegiate shooting team.
- Junior Shoot-Out Contestant Any person entered in the Junior Shoot-Out Trap Event, the Junior Shoot-Out Sporting Clays Event or the Junior Shoot-Out Modified Trap Event. **See** page 246 and 247 <u>Junior Shoot-Out Rules</u> for eligibility requirements.
- Youth Participant Any person between the ages of 8 and 18 on August 31, 2021 and in grades 3 to 12, who will be shooting on NSC grounds Wednesday, February 16 to Sunday, February 20, 2022, and is not a Junior Shoot-Out Contestant.

#### **EVENT**

This is a sporting clays competition consisting of one hundred (100) targets shot on a sporting clays course at the National Shooting Complex (NSC) in San Antonio, Texas. The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Junior Shoot-Out and National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) governing body rules apply to this event. San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Junior Shoot-Out exceptions take precedence over governing body rules. This is not a NSCA registered event.

#### **DATES**

The event will be held from Thursday February 17, 2022 to Saturday February 19, 2022

### COST

Cost is \$75 per entry.

# REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING

Registration and Squadding will be through iClays, and will open, on-line, on or before January 15, 2022 until Sunday February 13, 2022 after which it will be opened at Registration during the Junior Shoot-Out.

## SAFETY AND ORIENTATION

Everyone who shoots must attend an orientation prior to shooting. See page 246 and 247 of <u>Junior Shoot-Out Rules</u> for all safety and orientation requirements. **AWARDS** 

Refer to the <u>Junior Shoot-Out Rules</u> for Age Group breakdown. There will be awards in the following categories for Junior Shoot-Out contestants and Youth Participants combined:

- Age Group I Boys Champion, Runner-Up and Third Place
- Age Group I Girls Champion, Runner-Up and Third Place
- Age Group II Boys Champion, Runner-Up and Third Place
- Age Group II Girls Champion, Runner-Up and Third Place

There will be awards in the following categories for Collegiate Participants:

- Men Champion, Runner-Up and Third Place
- Women Champion, Runner-Up and Third Place

No prizes will be awarded to Adult Participants who shoot this event.

Participating in the event is automatic acceptance of this policy.
