



DryFire Shoot-Out

ELIGIBILITY

The DryFire Shoot-Out is open to all 4-H Clubs and FFA Chapters that have Junior Shoot-Out Contestants. Each 4-H Club or FFA Chapter will compete as a Team. A Junior Shoot-Out Contestant is any person entered in the USAS Modified Trap Event, Junior Shoot-Out Trap Event or Junior Shoot-Out Sporting Clays Event. See page 6 of the [Junior Shoot-Out Rules](#) for eligibility requirements.

EVENT

The DryFire Shoot-Out competition consists of fifteen (15) target round of simulated trap on a DryFire simulator. The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Junior Shoot-Out Rules apply to this event. Management reserves the right to make changes to the event.

DATES

The event will be held from Thursday at 12:00 PM until Saturday at 1:00 PM.

COST

Entry is free.

REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING

Teams can sign up at the DryFire building at the end of vendor's row.

SAFETY AND ORIENTATION

All contestants must comply with Junior Shoot-Out requirements. See page 8 and 9 of the [Junior Shoot-Out Rules](#) for all safety and orientation requirements.

PLAYERS GUIDE

Each participant in the event is allowed to shoot a 15 target trap round on the DryFire simulator. The first round shot by each team member will be scored as the official round. Other rounds may be shot for practice but only the first round will count for score. The top five (5) scores from each team will be added together and the winning team will be the team that breaks the greatest number of simulated targets. In the event of a tie, each tied team will select one (1) shooter from one of the top five scores to represent that team. The tiebreaker will be a miss and out shoot-off at the 20 yard line of a regular American trap field using the shooters own gun and ammunition.

AWARDS

The club of the winning team will receive a DryFire simulator.
