ELIGIBILITY

The Sponsor Annie Oakley is open to all 4-H Clubs and FFA Chapters that have Junior Shoot-Out Contestants. Each 4-H Club or FFA Chapter will compete as a Team. A Junior Shoot-Out Contestant is any person entered in the USAS Modified Trap Event, Junior Shoot-Out Trap Event, or Junior Shoot-Out Sporting Clays Event. See page 6 of the Junior Shoot-Out Rules for eligibility requirements.

EVENT

This game show style competition is to educate contestants regarding sponsors of the Junior Shoot-Out and to recognize sponsors for their support of our event.

DATES

The event will be held on Saturday during the Main Event Ceremony.

COST

Entry is free.

REGISTRATION

One entry form will be available in the Registration building for each Team. A representative for each Team may obtain the entry form. A signature from the Team representative will be required to pick up the entry form for your Team.

SAFETY AND ORIENTATION

All contestants must comply with Junior Shoot-Out requirements. See page 8 and 9 of the <u>Junior Shoot-Out Rules</u> for all safety and orientation requirements.

PLAYERS GUIDE

One entry form will be available in the Registration building for each Team. A representative for each Team may obtain the entry form. A signature from the Team representative will be required to pick up the entry form for your Team. All members of your Team may help answer the multiple-choice questions. Return the entry form to Registration by noon on Saturday, February 17, 2018. No late entry forms accepted.

All fully complete and fully correct forms will be entered in a random drawing to determine the 3 Teams to participate in the Sponsor Annie Oakley during the Main Event Ceremony on Saturday, February 17, 2018.

At the Main Event Ceremony, a random drawing will be held. If your Team is drawn, up to 4 representatives of your Team will take their position on the stadium infield. When all 3 Teams are in position, the contest will begin. Each team will draw a multiple-choice question pertaining to a major Junior Shoot-Out sponsor. **These questions will be different from the questions on the entry form.** Electronic devices will be allowed, and the names of the sponsors will be available to the contestants during the contest.

Team #1 draws a question. Only the Team representatives on the stadium infield may discuss the question. Team #1 will have 10 seconds to give an answer. If the answer is correct, Team #1 will score 10 points. If the answer is not correct, Team #2 will be given 10 seconds to answer the same question. If their answer is correct, Team #2 will score 10 points. If the answer is not correct, no points will be awarded to any team for that question. Then Team #2 draws a new question and the process is repeated until all questions have been drawn.

In the final round, each team will be able to wager any amount of points up to their total amount of points. The question will be read to all teams and each team will write their answer on a dry erase board. If the team gets the answer correct, the number of points wagered will be added to their total score. If the team has an incorrect answer, the number of points wagered will be deducted from the team's total. The team scoring the highest number of total points will be the winner.

In the event of a tie, each member of the tied teams will draw a numbered hull from a bucket of 50 hulls. Teams will alternate having their members draw the hulls. The team that has the member that draws the highest number hull will be the winning team.

AWARDS

Three Lincoln Trap machines will be awarded to the club of the winning Team.
