GENERAL INFORMATION

PAYMENTS - Credit cards (VISA, American Express, Master Card, Discover), checks and cash will be accepted.

REGISTRATION - Only by using the official prepayment form or <u>scorechaser.com</u> will prepayment of entry fees be accepted.

Registration Office will open Monday 12 PM - 5 PM and Tuesday - Sunday 7 AM - 5 PM. Main Event entry will close at 2 PM on Thursday.

DAILY FEE - \$5 per 100 on all registered targets.

MAINTENANCE FEE - A \$2 fee per 100 targets will be charged in all events shot during the Texas State tournament. These specially designated monies will be used for maintenance and/or improvements at the National Shooting Complex.

REFUNDS - No refunds of advance deposits or prepaid entry fees after Wednesday, April 30 except for emergencies. A written request must be submitted.

All entries are final. After April 30th, except for emergencies, entry fees will not be refunded unless the event is cancelled. Shoot management will consider emergency medical withdrawals accompanied by a written request.

ELIGIBILITY - All participants must be current members of the NSCA. Membership applications will be accepted at the shoot. Shooters are requested to provide their social security number at the time of entry so that award checks can be sent promptly. Per IRS regulations, shooters whose cash awards total \$600 or more must provide their social security number before payouts can be made to the shooter.

NO RE-ENTRY ON ANY EVENT

Only a resident of Texas can be recognized as the Texas State Champion, Runner-Up, and Third; class 1-6, and concurrent CH-3rd.

Non Texas Residents will have separate payouts and awards in the Main Event, see page 34 for details.

RULES & REGULATIONS - All NSCA rules apply. FITASC rules apply in all FITASC Event, including those applying to age. American Field Sporting rules apply to the 50-target AFS event.

PROTESTS AND CORRECTIONS – Corrections to scores, event and concurrent entries and entry into Special Concurrents should be reported to the Registration Desk as soon as they are noticed. It is vitally important for shooters to check the scoreboard to make certain they have been entered in all events for which they are qualified as no additions or corrections to Concurrent and Special Concurrent entries will be made after 12 PM Saturday, May 17. Shooters are urged to check their scores each day as corrections to awards will not be made unless Registration is notified prior to shoot-offs beginning or, in the case of awards not involved in ties, before 8 PM Sunday, May 18.

Protests must be submitted, in writing, to Shoot Management by 6 PM (or 15 minutes after last shot fired) the day the event is shot. Exception: Shooters needing to file a protest on an occurrence that happened on the last flight of the day must immediately report to Shoot Management for instructions. All protests must be made in accordance with NSCA, FITASC, or AFS rules and will be decided by the Protest Committee whose decision is final.

SHOOT-OFFS - All registered event shoot-offs will be held on Sunday. Shoot-off results take precedence over tiebreaker station results.

All ties in the Texas State Main Event Championship for Texas residents Open Champion, Runner-Up and Third, Class First- Fourth and Concurrent Champion, Runner-Up, and Third, and non Texas residents Champion, Runner-Up and Third, Class First, and Concurrent Champion will be shot off Sunday evening at the conclusion of all events. These shoot-offs will determine both awards and guaranteed cash. Ties for all other places will be decided by total score on predetermined tiebreaker stations.

In all other events, shoot-offs will be held only for Open Champion, Runner-Up and Third, Class First and Concurrent Champion. Ties for other places will be decided by total score on predetermined tiebreaker stations.

PAYMENT OF PURSES AND OPTIONS - All purse, option and other payments will be sent to shooters after the shoot. Checks for awards totaling \$600 or more will not be mailed until we have been provided with shooter's SSN.

RV SITES - For a camper site during this event, contact the Pro-Shop at 210-254-1526 or email at **nscrv@nssa-nsca.com**. All campers must check in with the Pro-Shop upon arrival.

EXHIBIT SPACE - Advanced reservations must be made with the Pro-Shop at 210-254-1526 or email at nscrv@nssa-nsca.com.

SHOTGUN STORAGE - Secure storage is available to shooters at a cost of \$5 per day per gun. Available starting Tuesday, May 13th.

TROPHIES AND PRIZES - In the main event belt buckles will be awarded to Champion, Runner-Up, Third, Lady Champion, Lady Runner-Up, Lady Third all other Concurrent Champions as well as all Class Champions. All other award winners will receive an award package in the mail that will allow them to choose their award based on place won. Instructions on the award procedure will be included in the award package.

Unless annotated on the page listing the individual events, all events will award in:

Class: Master - AA - A - B - C - D

Concurrent: Lady - Sub-Junior - Junior - Veteran - Super Veteran - Senior Super Veteran - Legacy

PRACTICE FIELDS - The sporting clays practice course will be open Monday 9 AM - 6PM and Tuesday – Sunday 7 AM - 6 PM.

CLAYS CARS - Individually-owned clays cars, Gators, Mules and other similar vehicles are allowed or, if you prefer, clays cars may be rented. No ATVs or 4-wheelers allowed. You must be at least 18 years old to operate a clays car. Special rules apply and permits are required for both personal and rental carts. Personal cart forms can be downloaded from bit.ly/TexasSC. A \$15 trail fee is required for all personal carts. A cart permit will be issued upon NSC receiving the trail fee and verifying insurance. For more specific information, contact Lori Bauchman at lbauchman@nssa-nsca.com. Rental Golf Cart forms are available at bit.ly/TexasSC.

PERSONAL CART INSURANCE - NSSA-NSCA-NSC has implemented a policy that proof of liability insurance is required for operation of personally-owned carts at the facility. Minimum liability, such as written for auto policies, for injury/accident is what is required. The policy is required to have reference to the cart that is to be operated and often can be added to current auto or home owner policies. Proof of insurance can be sent prior to your arrival via email to Lori Bauchman at lbauchman@nssa-nsca.com or by US Mail to:

Upon arrival, a permit, which must be displayed on the cart, will be available for pick-up in registration. If you are unable to send insurance prior to arrival, simply bring your proof of insurance to registration when you arrive and a permit will be produced and issued.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/LIGHTNING PLAN OF ACTION - The National Shooting Complex (NSC) will utilize a weather monitoring and alert system to detect the presence and occurrence of lightning and other hazardous weather conditions. Shoot Management will be notified, through the alert system, of lightning and any other potential dangerous elements.

If lightning is detected within 6 miles of NSC, a cease-fire will be called immediately via PA system and any other means where PA is not available. Shooting will suspend for a period of no less than 20 minutes. All fields will be cleared of both participants and staff, with all taking cover in available areas, i.e.: Club House, Vendor Buildings, vehicles, etc. Shoot management will continue to monitor lightning strikes, via the alert system. The weather alert system will automatically track the time after each lightning strike and a new time clock with start after any strike within the 6 mile radius. After the duration of 20 minutes with no strikes within the 6 mile radius, shoot management will begin the process of

returning participants to the field(s) to continue shooting. By starting this process at 20 minutes, the total elapsed time from the last strike until shooting begins is anticipated to be 30 or more minutes.

The above process will be repeated for any and all storms / lightning strikes observed. In the event of any other dangerous elements of an approaching storm, such as extremely high winds/ tornado or hail, the same cease-fire and field evacuation procedures as above will be implemented.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS- Mandatory eye and ear protection— all persons, spectators, shooters, referees and trap personnel must wear eye and ear protection on the course. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on the National Shooting Complex property.

SOLICITING - No literature of any kind may be distributed on the grounds without prior approval of the NSCA.

No refunds for withdrawals will be made because of weather unless the event is cancelled. Management decisions are final. In accordance with NSCA rules, Shoot Management may refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot or, in management's opinion, whose conduct is unsportsmanlike.

CONTINGENCY PLAN

If shooting of any Main Event Course or Courses, at the TX State Shoot are cancelled by shoot management, due to the occurrence of dangerous weather conditions, natural disaster, act of God, or events beyond the direct, immediate control of the club or Shoot management of the TX State Shoot, the following procedure will be used to establish all awards including the TX State Shoot Champion and all Class and Concurrent Awards.

In the event of any cancellation for any event by shoot management, a refund will be given to anyone affected by the cancellation. In the event that anyone has made the decision to drop out from any event on their own accord without shoot management cancelling the event or rotation they will not be given a refund.

In the event of course cancellation on any rotation that cannot be made-up, all competitors will receive on all rotations the corresponding total of targets (i.e. 66, or 68) depending on which course they were not able to complete. If any competitor is not capable to complete at least two courses there will not be TX State Champion Crowned.

If there is any cancellation due to conditions deemed appropriate by shoot management, then all misses will be counted based on the targets attempted. The total number of misses will determine the number of competitors in the shoot offs to determine all Class and Concurrent champions including HOA, Runner-up, and Third.

In the Main Event 10 competitors in each class will be taken to shootoffs as well as 5 in each concurrent determined by the total number of misses. These shootoffs will consist of an initial 10 targets in the shootoff location followed by a miss and out format to determine the class and concurrent champions.

HOA, RU, and 3rd will be determined by taking the top 10 competitors based on total misses for the completed courses. They will compete in a 25 target super final which will be followed by another 25 bird super final until the HOA RU and 3rd positions are determined.

All shoot off targets will be added to the total accumulative score from the main event rotations that were completed.

Certainly no contingency plan for an uncontrollable event or series of events can cover every possibility; or, incorporate the multitude of alternative approaches each shooter might prefer. To be workable, the plan must be straight forward, simple as possible, and executable. The above plan most closely fulfills these objectives.

We are glad you are here on this momentous occasion to enjoy the festivities.


