

## JSO Teams

Entry Forms and payment will be handled through registration.

Rules and a sample entry form will be in the Information Center (Ammo Barn)

- Team Members Guidelines:
  - All Team Members must be from the same Club/Organization. Same 4H Club or same FFA Club
  - Do not have to be from the same age group
  - Teams can be mixed gender
  - Contestants can only be on ONE (1) team per discipline, but can be on different teams for different disciplines
  - Must have one member identified as Team Captain
  - Payment is due when the entry is submitted - No Refunds
  - Must have all 3 members listed on the entry form
  - No Team Member Substitutions after the entry deadline
- Entry Fee: \$10/member/team. Total \$30 per team
- Teams will only be for the following events:
  - Doubles Trap - American Trap - Sporting Clays
- Prizes will only be awarded to Open Class High Overall team in each discipline (Dbls Trap, Am Trap, Sporting Clays)
  - Open 4-H
    - Champion Team \$1,500 (\$500/team member)
    - Runner Up Team – Prizes award to each team member
    - 3rd Place Team - Prizes award to each team member
  - Open FFA
    - Champion Team \$1,500 (\$500/team member)
    - Runner Up Team – Prizes award to each team member
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Team - Prizes award to each team member
- No Shoot-Offs: All ties will be handled as follows:
  - Dbls Trap
    - Ties will be broken by the cumulative score of all team members using the sub event 50's in order, 1st then 2nd. If there is still a tie, long run from front, again cumulative of all team members will be used and if still tied then long run cumulative all team members from the back. If there is still a tie, a coin flip will determine placings.
  - Am Trap
    - Ties will be broken by the cumulative score of all team members using the sub event 25's in order, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th. If there is still a tie, long run from front, again cumulative of all team members will be used and if still tied then long run cumulative all team members from the back. If there is still a tie, a coin flip will determine placings.
  - Sporting Clays
    - Ties will be broken by the cumulative score of all team members on pre-determined tiebreaker station(s) from the East Course. If there is still a tie after comparing all 12 stations of the East Course, the same process will be followed using the West Course. If there is still a tie, a coin flip will determine placings.
- Team submissions and substitutions are due by:
  - Doubles Trap – close of registration Wednesday, Feb 11<sup>th</sup>
  - Trap & Sporting Clays – close of registration Thursday, Feb 12<sup>th</sup>
